EARLY RELEASE— We will be open to receive the children whenever schools release the children. If weather is dangerously bad, we will be closing early and you will be notified as to when you need to pick up your children by text and/or e-mail.

SCHOOL CLOSINGS— Closing will be based on local road conditions. You will receive a text/e-mail message no later than 6:30. Closings will also be listed on WHSV under businesses. It will also be listed if we are open and what our hours will be for the day. Most snow day hours are 8:30—5:30.
